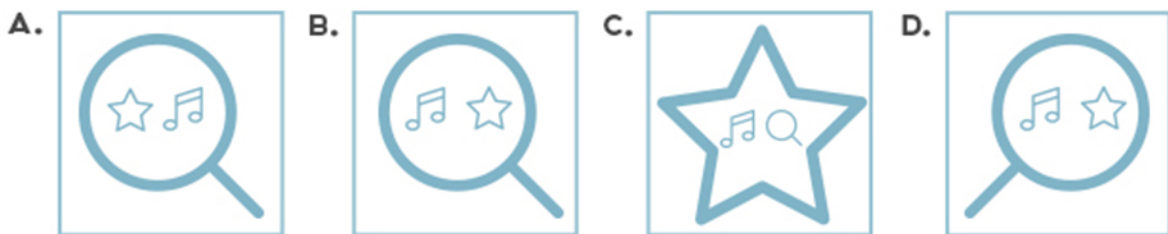
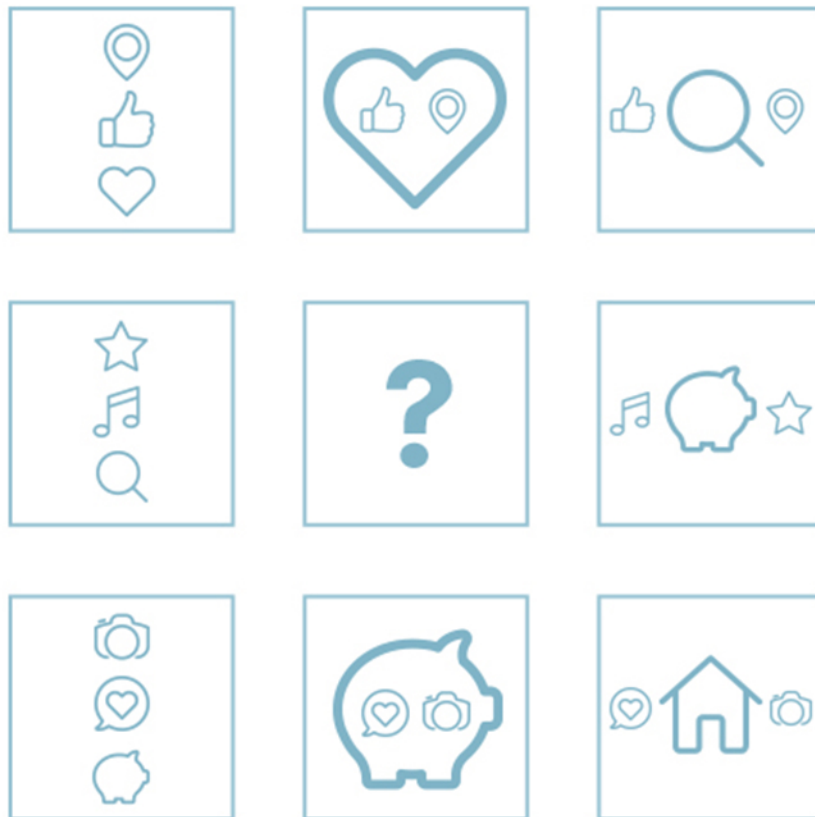

Answer Key:

1. B. 16: Jennifer would have to be 16 and Jonathan would have to be 32 for their combined ages to be 48.
2. D. Cookies: Dessert: Sneakers are a type of shoe just like cookies are a type of dessert. By contrast, a table is made from wood, clothes belong in a closet, and a collar is a part of a dress.
3. E: E is the only choice where the flaps are folded down from the edges of the square and not from the corners.
4. D. $2+3+5$: Entries 2, 3, and 5 have errors.
5. A. Obscure: Manifest has two meanings. It means both evident or conspicuous and to demonstrate. Obscure is the opposite of the first meaning of the word, and capacious is unrelated.
6. B. Glass: Jar: In the example given, the first word, silk, is the material of the second word, shirt. B is the correct answer because a jar can be made from glass.
7. B. The answer should follow the pattern both horizontally and vertically. That's why the answer should show a diamond with a box on the right and a figure-8 on the left.
8. C. Incarcerate: Liberate means to set free while incarcerate means to put in jail. So, they are clear opposites. Emancipate and redeem are both synonyms, and deliver is unrelated.
9. A. 54: The pattern's rule is as follows: multiply the first number by three to get to the third number and then multiply by three to get to the fifth number, and so on. Then subtract 6 from the second number to get to the fourth number and then again to get to the sixth number.
10. C. 150: $24 \times 6.25 = 150$
